

NORMS FOR B.TECH. SPOT ADMISSION ON 10.08.2017

(Ref: Letter No. No.CEE/4050/2016/KEAM-2017/TA1

**Dated:27.07.2017 of the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations,
Government of Kerala)**

1. Admission will be purely based on the rank obtained by the student in the Kerala Entrance Exam -2017.
2. Candidates/parents are to report to at 10 am on 10/08/2017, for registration. Applications will be registered upto 10.30 am only. Candidates reported after 10.30 am will not be considered under any circumstances.
3. Vacancy Positions in various branches along with the quota/community reservations will be published separately at the college website.
4. The annual tuition fee applicable will be Rs.35,000/- for Government quota seats and Rs.65,000/- for management quota seats. Besides this, an institutional fee of Rs.18,788/- is to be remitted at the time of admission.
5. Copies of entrance rank certificate and plus two mark list should be attached with the application.
6. A rank list based on the entrance rank obtained by the valid registered candidates will be published at 11.00 am or as and when it is ready.
7. Candidates will be called for a counseling based on their order in the rank list and the branch will be allotted according to the vacancy and their choice. After counselling a waiting list will be published for the remaining candidates (branch -wise).
8. The students who are offered admission in the counselling have to remit a token amount of Rs.30,000/- for confirming their admission on the spot itself (at the SBI branch in the college), failing which seat will be offered to the next candidate in the rank list/waiting list.

Certificates in original to be produced at the time of admission:

1. Admit card
2. Rank Certificate
3. Certificate to prove age
4. Mark list of qualifying examination
5. Pass Certificate
6. Transfer Certificate
7. Conduct Certificate
8. Medical Fitness Certificate from a Medical Officer not below the rank of Asst. Surgeon (format given in the prospectus)

9. If no candidate is available for seats against the community reservation quota, the seats will be converted to the open quota.
10. If any candidate, after confirming admission by remitting the token fee, fails to report for joining before the stipulated time, his/her admission will be forfeited without any notice and the token amount remitted will be refunded, after deducting a processing fee of Rs.5,000/-, that too only after 20/08/2017.
11. If any vacancy arises due to the leaving of any student (who has been already admitted to this college) on or before 15/08/2017 that vacancy will also be filled up from the rank list/waiting list according to the option order filed by the student at the time of registration. Hence, the order of option be given so carefully, as it is not possible to change/cancel it later.
12. Even if no vacancy exists in certain branches, at the time of spot admission, a waiting list will be prepared for admission to that branch from the spot admission and that will be considered for filling up the vacancies arising later. The candidates can opt for any branch, even if no vacancy is there at the time of spot admissions, as a waiting list will be prepared based on the higher options.
13. The clauses of 6.2.2 and 11.6.9 in the Prospectus of KEAM 2017 are applicable to this spot admission.
14. Students admitted under the NRI quota in this college is not eligible for attending the spot admission.
